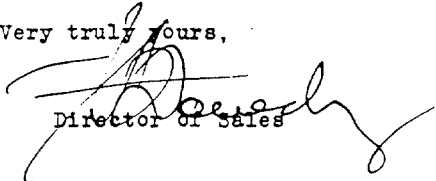

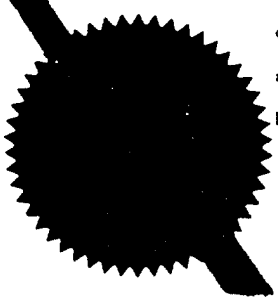

STATEMENT.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that ANACONDA LEAD PRODUCTS COMPANY, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, and doing business and having its principal offices in said State of Delaware, and having eastern offices in New York county of New York, State of New York (post-office address 42 Broadway, New York), has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing (applicant hereby disclaims the words "White Lead Dry" and "East Chicago, Ind." apart from

the mark shown), for white lead, both dry and in oil, in Class 16, Paints and painters' materials.

The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation since July 30, 1919.

The trade-mark is preferably applied by applying a stencil to the containers or kegs, or the mark may be placed on the goods by applying a printed label to the containers.
