Dear Paul:

In conjunction with your letter of October 2nd you will find enclosed some of the newspaper clippings pertaining to the situation in Port Allegany. I am also enclosing for your general information a copy of the recommendation by Dr. Holstein concerning a health monitoring program management refused to go along with. Also enclosed is a copy of the report we received from Mt. Sinai Hospital as a result of the union sending thirty-eight of the exposed men to Paterson, New Jersey for examination.

We had intended to send you a copy of our entire file on Port Allegany, however, we have been enjoined as a defendant in the lawsuit by the PPG Company. Our attorney advises us that some of this correspondence may be privileged and if we make it available to others, we may destroy the privilege status.

I trust that what we are sending on to you will give you a good idea of what has been taking place in Port Allegany. When you are assigned to Port Allegany, we will have an International Representative Jack Smoogen work with you for a week or so. Jack is totally familiar with the background of the asbestos situation and the community of Port Allegany.
