In speaking with Craig Dalby, Pacific West Region Public Information, a telecon has taken place between Regional Director Laura Joss and the Stevens County Commissioners since the letter provided to you in the original request (that original letter is attached and named Undated Letter). As a result of the telecon, the other attached letter was drafted by the Stevens County Commissioners, dated August 23, 2017, and sent to Laura Joss which indicates both sides are still working to resolve the lease issue for Lake Roosevelt Vacations, Inc. Superintendent Dan Foster of LARO is working with the board to resolve the matter.

As for the lease for Camp Na bor lee at LARO, that matter is currently with the Solicitor's Office at the Pacific Northwest Regional Office in Portland, OR. There is no update on this issue at this time.
