

FOREWORD

The third conference of the American Brake Shoe Company's industrial nurses was held at Moraine-on-the-Lake, Highland Park, Illinois on September 13-16, 1953. As in the past, the value of such gatherings was amply demonstrated. Company nurses from widely scattered locations were afforded the opportunity of meeting each other and becoming acquainted with over-all Company policies in a manner which would not have been possible otherwise.
