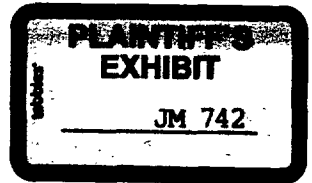

- (i) The nature of the facilities provided; Willow Operators Locker Room and other procedures and equipment noted in attached copy of Denison P.D.O.M. 6.3.9.6-1 dated 11/2/78.
- (ii) When were they first provided?
Showers -- 1958 for any employee to use in Hourly Locker Rooms. 1978 for Willow Operators only in Special Locker Room.
- (iii) Use of Protective clothing and respirators is mandatory in areas as described in the attached P.D.O.M. 6.3.9.6-1 the use of showers is not mandatory but recommended to Willow Operators. Sanctions for failure to use are noted in P.D.O.M. 6.1.4.2 "Uniform Application of Discipline". Page 3, Para. 8.0 "Failure to Wear Personal Protective Equipment" P.D.O.M. 6.1.4.2, attached.
- (iv) All operators are instructed (verbally) by their immediate Shift Supervisor to wear and use protective clothing and equipment provided by the Company. They are encouraged to use shower available to them in their Special Locker Room. He is further advised that violations of the P.D.O.M. 6.3.9.6-1 will result in disciplinary action.
