Dear Mr. Schaefer:

I am sending you herewith a carbon copy of the material which it seems to me advisable to make into placards for use at all barrel mixing plants in this country and elsewhere. I have sent a copy to Mr. Mittnacht for his criticism on the questions of whether the use of Ethyl Gasoline Corporation and Ethyl Export Corporation is proper and legal, and whether the notation with regard to "Q" Fluid is in satisfactory form. Please return the copy to me with any criticisms or comments or with a notation of your approval.

If you have no criticism to offer, please drop Mr. Mittnacht a line promptly signifying your approval of the instructions in their present form in order that he may proceed at once to submit the original copy to the printer. If any criticisms develop either at your hands or in his office, I will submit a new copy in its final form taking into account the criticisms, as quickly as I can.

I am revamping the book of regulations of which this is only a part. In the new book I am issuing certain instructions and advice to the management at mixing plants but I do not think it advisable to print this material on the cards. The cards are intended primarily for the workmen and should not be used for other purposes.
