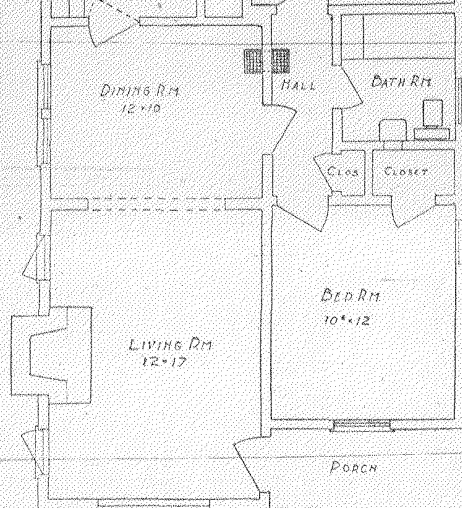
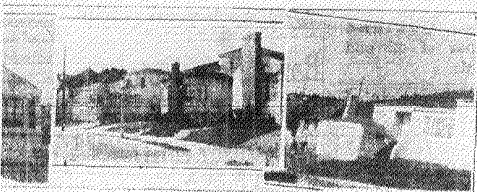

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trees and shrubs which can be planted in containers, move easily even in midsummer. Warm soil quicker root growth, and lessens the shock of moving. Often the weather, with pleasant evenings and longer day gives the gardener an opportunity to spend more time at his hobby and do a more thorough job of it.

Since most annuals, perennial and bulbous plants have a regular period of growth and bloom which must be considered, gardening automatically falls into similar periods. Naturally, the planting suggestion which follow are elastic and vary slightly according to special conditions of location and necessity, but in general may be followed with supplementary suggestions from your nurserymen or other local gardeners.

SEPTEMBER SCHEDULE

Upon returning from your vacation in August, you probably did a little remodeling and replaced evergreen shrubs or trees, or perhaps put in a few roses or selecter fuchsias while in bloom. If you began planting bulbous plants such as bearded irises, this may be continued in September. The garden should be cleared of early annuals to make room for more bulbs. The so-called Cape bulbs, frezias, sparaxis, streptantheras, tritonas and ixias should be planted as soon as they can be obtained. Daffodils are usually ready in the latter part of September and planting may be done at any convenient time.

Cinerarias may go in now and sweet peas of the early flowering types should be planted for Winter bloom. This type of sweet pea should not be pinched back although pinching improves the late flowering sort. There is still time to plant stocks which will make strong plants before cold weather and bloom right through the Winter. Snapdragons can also be put in in early September.

TRANSPLANTING EVERGREENS

October is a particularly good month for moving nonflowering evergreens such as cedars, pines, etc. It is the main bulb planting month. Daffodils, tulips, Dutch iris, anemones, ranunculus and some kinds of grape hyacinths and some kinds of lilies should go in as soon as the weather gets cooler. Tulips might well be left until November if warm weather holds through in October. Along with bulb planting, there will be many bedding and border

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
