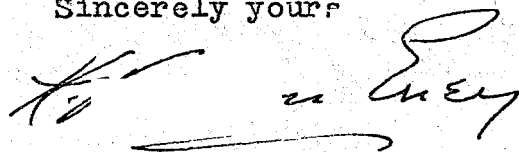
I have your letter of March 1, 1951, in reply to my letter to Mr. Cholak of February 24, 1951, and note that you have sent copies to each of the other counsel.
