## **Gov. Scott Announces Sixteen Appointments to Multiple State Boards**

**TALLAHASSEE, Fla.** – Today, Governor Rick Scott announced twelve reappointments and four appointments to multiple state boards.

### **Gulf Coast State College District Board of Trustees**

Steve Millaway, 61, of Panama City Beach, is the founder and managing director of TechFarms Capital and the CEO of TechFarms, LLC. Millaway is reappointed for a term beginning December 15, 2017, and ending May 31, 2021.

Donald Crisp, 74, of Panama City Beach, is the retired vice president of First American Title Insurance. Crisp is reappointed for a term beginning December 15, 2017, and ending May 31, 2021.

David Warriner, 53, of Port St. Joe, is the owner of Warriner-Tapper Investments. Warriner is reappointed for a term beginning December 15, 2017, and ending May 31, 2021.

Elizabeth Kirvin, 46, of Apalachicola, is the assistant principal of Apalachicola Bay Charter School and a founding board member. Kirvin is reappointed for a term beginning December 15, 2017, and ending May 31, 2020.
