In accordance with our September 25, 1975 telephone conversation, I am enclosing nine samples collected on Millipore filters (MAWP037A0, pore size 0.8 μ , lot #21703) for asbestos fiber analyses. In addition, there are two bulk samples of dust collected from brake drum and clutch housings. These should be analyzed for asbestos content. Upon completion of your analyses, I would appreciate your returning the unused portion of the air samples and bulk dust to me in order that I can send them to our Houston laboratory for collaborative analyses.
