Subject: Request of a meeting from various trade associations on PFHxA

Dear [REDACTED],

The European Tyre & Rubber Manufacturers Association (ETRMA) and Fluoropolymers Product Group at Plastics Europe (FPG) wrote a letter to Mr. Flueh, requesting a meeting to exchange on the proposed restriction proposal of undecafluorohexanoic acid (PFHxA), its salts and related substances in January 2021. Replying to this letter your Service indicated that “We are open to meet you and other stakeholders later in the process, i.e. when the Commission has received the RAC and SEAC opinions from ECHA”.

SEAC adopted its final opinion at the beginning of December and RAC earlier in June. We understand that the SEAC and RAC discussions left various points open especially on the thresholds but not exclusively.

The European Tyre & Rubber Manufacturers Association (ETRMA), European Automobile Manufacturers’ Association (ACEA), European Association of Automotive Suppliers (CLEPA) Fluoropolymers Product Group at Plastic Europe (FPG) and The Motorcycle industry in Europe (ACEM) would like to share with you some thoughts on a possible way forward and to receive your feedback to these. May we therefore ask for a meeting with you possibly in the second half of January 2022.
