The Committee will also conduct a final review of grant applications for Federal assistance. Although it is anticipated that this entire portion of the meeting will be held in open session, it may be necessary to close the part of this meeting during which the qualifications of an applicant are discussed if such disclosure would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)).

Agenda items are subject to change as priorities dictate.

**FURALADONE (NF-2801), NITROFURAZONE (NF-7), NITRODAZONE (NF-64):
OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING ON PROPOSAL TO WITHDRAWAL APPROVAL OF CERTAIN NEW ANIMAL DRUG APPLICATIONS**

Extension of Time for Requesting a Hearing

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is extending to October 16, 1978 the time for requesting a hearing on notices of opportunity for hearing on proposal to withdraw approval of new animal drug applications providing for use of furaladone (NF-2801), nitrofurazone (NF-7), and nitrodazone (NF-64).

The notices, which were published in the FEDERAL REGISTER of August 17, 1978 (41 FR 34891, 34899, and 34903), gave interested persons to September 18, 1978 for requesting a hearing.

The Director of the FDA Bureau of Veterinary Medicine has received a request for an extension of an additional

30 days to respond to the subject notices. Because of the amount of scientific material in the notices, which must be reviewed and evaluated, the request for an additional 30 days is granted.

Therefore, under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (sec. 512, 21 Stat. 343-351) (21 U.S.C. 360b) and under authority delegated to the Commissioner (21 CFR 5.1) and redelegated to the Director of the Bureau of Veterinary Medicine (21 CFR 5.29) (recodification published in the FEDERAL REGISTER of June 15, 1978 (41 FR 24283)), the time for filing requests for a hearing on the subject notices is extended to October 16, 1978.
