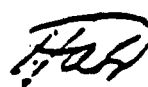

You will recall that at our meeting with Dr. Crowley they indicated that they would not be in a position to initiate a medical study until this summer even if they did choose to do so. Secondly, it is my guess that they will want to see the results of the mortality study which they are making before making such a decision. As a result, I suggest we wait for them to make the first move.

When we get a little time, I would like to review with you what our current plans are in Libby. We believe we have found a set of circuits along with a new reagent system which will remove the asbestos in the wet state. We are in the process of requesting a preliminary engineering study which will lead to an RCA for building a new mill.
