

1 A I think he may have. I don't specifically
2 recall that, but since the first case reports appeared
3 in '35, he could well have mentioned it.

4 Q And those first case reports were Drs. Lynch
5 and Smith down in South Carolina, medical college in
6 South Carolina in Charleston?

7 A Yes.

8 Q Okay. So there were reports in the medical
9 and scientific literature in 1935, and they continued
10 on about the findings of bronchogenic carcinoma and
11 association with asbestosis?

12 A That is correct.

13 Q In fact, they also appeared in Dr.
14 Dreessen's report in 1938, there were about four or
15 five case reports that are attached to the
16 bibliography that discussed --

17 A That is about all that existed then, but he
18 cites them.

19 Q But they were there?

20 A Yes.

21 Q Now, 1946 Fleischer-Drinker.
