Pursuant to your regulations for the Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, the following information is submitted for The Sherwin-Williams Company and its affiliates. Of the products exempted from prohibition against sale, Sherwin-Williams markets lead-based paints which would be described as automotive refinish, touch-up, graphic arts, industrial maintenance, and industrial. Within the description industrial maintenance will be found lead primers for structural materials.
