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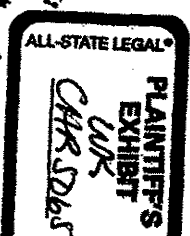

Dear Sirs:

On May 10, 1968 we conducted a survey of your asbestos brake lining and
framing operations to determine whether those operations were creating a health
hazard and abated the amount of asbestos being placed in each case.

It was found that the brake lining operations was still in the pilot plant
phase and experimental work was still being conducted on the framing line. It
was also found that it did not appear to be a health hazard; however, when those processes
are conducted full time, improved ventilation will be necessary and samples should
be taken to evaluate the hazard more completely. When the plant is available
for the production process for the brake lining, we would appreciate being able
to check over the ventilation provided.
