In this final rule dated June 8, 1992, OSHA is removing the nonasbestiform minerals from the scope of the revised 1986 standards for asbestos.

This removal is based on the determination by the Agency that the health effects data is insufficient to conclude that the nonasbestiform forms of tremolite, anthophyllite and actinolite present the same magnitude or type of effect as their asbestiform analogues.
