SEASONAL REMINDERS

ASBESTOS

Recent studies by medical authorities tend to show some possible connection between inhalation of asbestos dust and cancer. Be certain that all persons who work in the vicinity of asbestos are wearing a proper respirator approved by the U. S. Bureau of Mines for asbestos dust.

WIRE ROPE SURVEY

A first quarter report on your wire rope survey is due in the office of the Safety Director not later than April 15.

WELDERS CLOTHING

This is very much a "Hot" subject in more ways than one. Recent surveys show that our welders and burners are still wearing flammable clothing. Why wait until a man is burned to death to correct this hazard?

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HAZARDS OF SCALDING WATER

Three men were severely burned when showered by scalding water during a plant operation to clean out a stopped drain. The temperature of the water was known but correction of exposure by the wearing of protective clothing etc. was not taken. Next time your men do a job where there is any possibility of burns from hot water be certain and take ALL precautions necessary.

As a part of the continual effort of Safety Training and Education, the Safety Director is developing a series of colored slides and script covering safety subjects, taken and applicable to our operations.
