Mr. Wormser occupied the chair.

The chairman stated that in view of present developments in the white lead industry the question had been raised as to whether or not this program should be continued.

Mr. Zeller stated that he was in complete agreement with the aims of this program but that, inasmuch as no concrete proposals had yet been placed before this committee, there was not much that could be done at the present time.

Mr. Merson agreed with Mr. Zeller and suggested that the program suspend operations in 1948, and that the money already subscribed by cooperating companies (\$10,034.00) be held by the Association until such time as there is a need for cooperative research.

Mr. Rhyt also agreed and suggested that the technical committee not be dissolved with the hope that they continue to give some thought to the aims of this program.

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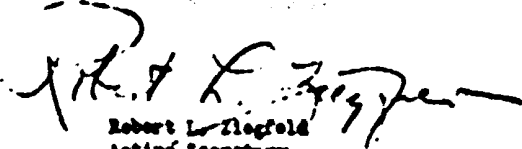
