

1 Q Why not?

2 A We did not finish all of the area samples.
3 Although we do have some data, it was also, I guess,
4 not as important for the individual exposure that we
5 were determining.

6 Q Would it be fair to say, Doctor, that your
7 area sample results which were taken approximately
8 five feet away from the individual doing the activity
9 were lower than the personal results?

10 A Yes, it is fairly common. That is what you
11 would expect, the bystander exposure would be less
12 than the individual doing the activity.

13 Q Now, I believe at your deposition you gave
14 me some copies of your raw data, and I think for the
15 sanding activity you took an area sampling that
16 resulted in about .77 fibers.

17 Do you recall that, or would you need to
18 look at the raw data?

19 A I would need to look at the raw data.
