The interesting features of this illness are period of onset, rapidity of onset, rapidity of increase in symptoms after onset, short period of illness until death.

- 1 day to complete job
- 3 men on job
- 1 ill (this is not certain as others might have been)
- 1 died

Factors responsible:

1. Failure to wear mask
2. No skin protection
3. Ate lunch and slept in tank
4. Tank idle 30 days prior to cleaning
