

1 I, for example, read the New York Academy of
2 Science symposium on asbestos and disease shortly
3 after it came out in 1966.

4 But to review the older literature, I did
5 that after I had examined a patient who was a
6 plaintiff in an asbestos trial, and the attorney for
7 whom I did the exam asked me if I would also go back
8 and review the earlier literature and testify as to
9 the historic development of knowledge.

10 That was done in 1978, the first time.

11 Q And have you kept up to date on the
12 development of knowledge related to asbestos
13 diseases?

14 A Well, as it has occurred since '78. The old
15 stuff hasn't changed. The literature is the
16 literature and you can't change it.

17 Q Doctor, have you done a systematic review of
18 Owens-Corning Fiberglas' documents?

19 A No.

20 Q Why haven't you done that?

21 A I don't really know how to interpret them.
