

1 to 25 percent of his automobile mechanic work during
2 his entire career.

3 Also, from 1957 through the early '80s part
4 of Mr. Grewe's exposure to asbestos-containing dust
5 resulted from his repair, removal and installation of
6 clutch friction plates which contained chrysotile
7 asbestos and some of which were supplied by Ford.

8 If you can assume that those facts are true,
9 do you have an opinion to a reasonable degree of
10 medical certainty as to which, if any, exposures to
11 Ford -- those Ford products were substantial
12 contributing factors to the development of Mr. Grewe's
13 mesothelioma, malignant mesothelioma?

14 MR. WILLIAMS: Objection, Your Honor.

15 THE COURT: Overruled.

16 Q You may answer.

17 A I think that all of those exposures were a
18 contributing factor into his mesothelioma.

19 Q And what is the basis of that opinion,
20 Doctor?
