Dear Mr. Locker:

Please be advised that on February 21, 1984, a hearing was held before the Industrial Commission of Ohio upon the issue of the C-92A Application For Increase in Percentage of Permanent Partial Disability filed on behalf of the claimant in the captioned claim. The claimant was not present at the hearing, but was represented by counsel. The undersigned was present at the hearing on behalf of the Sherwin Williams Company.

This claim, as you will recall, arose from the claimant's insistence that her work with cleaning solvents, along with exposure to paint chemicals, during a two-year period is approximately 1974-1975, resulted in an occupational-related condition of irritative conjunctivitis and rhinitis. Following numerous hearings and medical examinations relating to the issue of causation, this claim was finally allowed for rhinitis and conjunctivitis in 1977. In 1978, the claimant received an award of 15% Permanent Partial Disability.
