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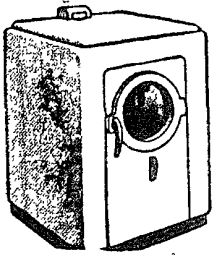

"In America you have wide fairways," says the 42-year-old pro. "It's only natural that the golfers will sacrifice accuracy for distance. For our championships in England we let the grass grow in the fairway. When we cut the grass the fairways are narrowed. This makes our courses tougher on long ball hitters but makes golf a game of accuracy which I think it should be. After all, the game was designed for everybody."
