Gentlemen:

In response to your recent letter relative to our installing tank car unloading equipment for Ethyl fluid at the Refinery, it is our intention to install this equipment at the Refinery this Fall.

One of your representatives recently visited our Refinery and advised that unless we were going to install tank car unloading equipment at this time, it would be necessary for us to put a concrete rinsing platform under our whole drum holding rack, together with a few other minor changes, which in the total would aggregate a rather large expense.

We are wondering, in view of our intention of installing the tank car unloading equipment for Ethyl fluid not later than this Fall, if it would be satisfactory with you for us to continue our present equipment until such time as the tank car unloading equipment is installed.
