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► **Lung cancer among HPI workers is a raging issue** in the U.S. OSHA, EPA, Toxic Substances Control Act administrators and the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health are investigating. So far, validity of charges being hurled about is in question. Monsanto polychlorinated biphenyls workers at St. Louis turned up with cancer. An investigation produced no "correlation" with PCB exposure. But Mobil Oil apparently found such a correlation in PCB workers at its Paulsboro, N.J. plant, says NIOSH. Other HPI companies—processing other products—face similar problems. They're investigating and adjusting accordingly (see January issue, pages 213-226). ✓

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
