Dutch Boy soft paste white-lead is ready for tinting and final thinning just as it comes in the keg. It reduces to paint quickly and easily when the user stirs in more linseed oil and the usual drier and "turps." A "hundred" of

this soft paste can be brought to brushing consistency at the rate of a gallon of paint a minute.

It's easy to tint, too. And, because of its smoothness, the resulting paint has excellent spreading qualities.

Dutch Boy soft paste white-lead comes in 100 pound steel kegs, and in 50, 25 and 12½ pound steel pails, plainly marked "Soft Paste."
