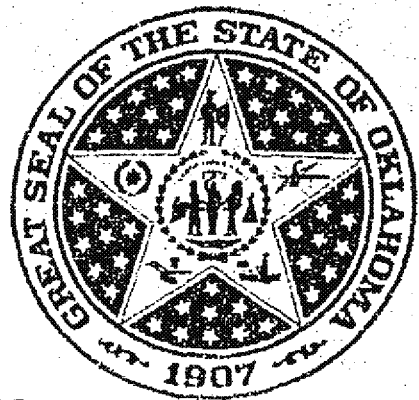
CERTIFICATE OF LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Oklahoma Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act"), does hereby execute the following Articles of Organization:

First. The name of the limited liability company is Pruitt's Auto Broker's L.L.C.

Second. The latest date on which the Company is to dissolve is November 22, 2099.

Third. The purpose of which the Company is formed is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the Act.

Fourth. The street address of the principal place of business of the Company is 2604 East Kenosha, Ste. #219, Broken Arrow, OK 74012.

Fifth. The name and address of the registered agent of the Company in the State of Oklahoma is Edward K. Pruitt, of 2604 East Kenosha, Ste. #219, Broken Arrow, OK 74012.
