You may be interested in the enclosed letter that AIA/NA received from the State of Hawaii. On checking further we learned that Hawaii has a two-house legislature that adjourned on April 11. The state senate had 1733 bills introduced and 81 passed. The state legislature worked harder with 1990 bills introduced and 136 passed. The Washington contact that supplied this information has only a numerical listing of these 3723 bills and their content and will "eyeball" to see if the bill in question can be located.

It is obviously too late for any input on the bill this year. Hopefully it died somewhere in committee but we will continue to track to get the true situation defined. If nothing shows from the Washington contact it may be simplest to get back to your Mr. C. Gramlich to learn where he got his information. I'll let you know what we find out.

We have an agreement with the City and County of Honolulu to have its Building Department serve as our plan reviewers. Therefore, I cannot understand your problem stated in your letter of April 9. We have no specific code of our own -- we depend on the professional expertise of the Building Department, which enforces a Building Code that, according to your letter, has no restrictions on the use of tape joint compounds containing asbestos fibers.

If you have information about a specific regulation of this type that we are "enforcing", please forward this to me.

Enclosed are our law and regulations pertaining to Factory Built Housing.
