

Our basic strategy for coping with the problem is to direct our attention to the following:

1. Actively seeking more information on the identification, toxicity and degradability of our Aroclors.
2. Working closely with our plants and our customers to control the discharge of Aroclors to the environment.
3. For those uses in which Aroclors cannot be contained, are resistant to degradation and are harmful to the environment we will replace these Aroclors with modified chlorinated biphenyls which do degrade or with substitute products. In those instances for which no acceptable substitute is developed we will voluntarily discontinue sale.
4. Developing processes for reclaiming Aroclor-containing ^{fluids} recovered from our customers.
5. Design and install incineration facilities for the total destruction of wastes.

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
