4 Teeners Held In Extortion

NEW YORK, April 22.—(INS)—Four New York City Teen-agers today were held on charges of extorting more than \$4,000 in protection money from a 15-year-old Brooklyn youth.

John J. Gebbia, 18, the gang leader, allegedly approached Raymond Quinones for money in April, 1956, threatening to kill his mother or sister if he didn't pay.

The Brooklyn youngster told police he started paying \$5 a week but the gang's demands grew until they were collecting \$80 weekly.

Quinones reported the affair to police after he learned the heavy payments, made from the till of his father's store, were driving the elder Quinones to bankruptcy.

Gebbia was held in \$15,000 bail for a Friday hearing. His three co-defendants will have juvenile hearings tomorrow.

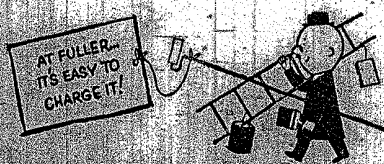
