FURTHER ORDER

Counsel for all parties appeared before this court on June 25, 1991 for a settlement conference. At that time it emerged that productive discussions must await further clarification of the status of the parties. With this in mind, the court orders as follows:

1. On or before July 12, 1991 the plaintiff will report to this court, in writing, regarding the status of current defendants Conoco and Union Carbide.

2. Also by that date, the plaintiff will convey to the defendants, in writing, her counter-demand. This communication should contain a specification of the plaintiff's calculation of special damages, including lost wages (past and future), medical expenses and the like. If plaintiff is relying on more than one theory of recovery, it would be helpful if the demand letter allocated portions of the total demand among these various theories. In any event, the demand should factor in some percentage to recognize the possibility of a defendants' verdict in this case.

3. Counsel will appear again before this court for a further settlement conference on September 4, 1991 at 2:00 p.m. The court is not ordering, but plaintiff's counsel may wish to consider the appropriateness of having plaintiff herself present for this conference. Because of the delay in scheduling the conference due to various vacations, the court will extend the period for completion of discovery appropriately, if necessary.
