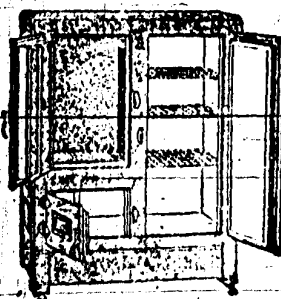
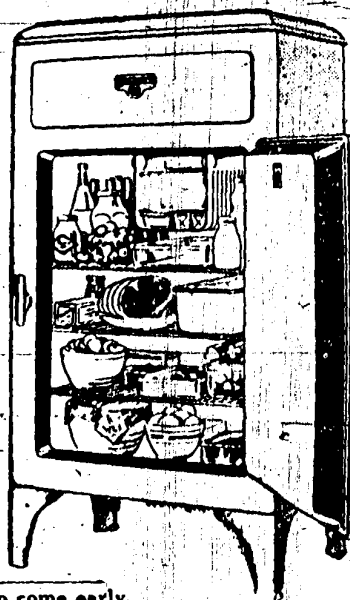

Placerville Home Destroyed by Fire

PLACERVILLE, April 5.—The home of George L. Maxwell, 2 miles east of Placerville, on Web Creek, was completely destroyed, an early morning fire yesterday. Loss was estimated at more than \$1000 by Weber, who said he carried no insurance.
