Although this is 4 1/2 months later from the time of the letter, it no means says that it took us 4 1/2 months to get all of the results recorded.

I am attaching a copy of your letter and the Safety Survey for your convenience so that it is not necessary for you to dig into your files at the present time.

- #1. I have taken the copy of the Respirator Program from Birmingham and have rewritten it only in respect to location and my name in place of Jack Lovell's.

Each employee has received a copy. A copy is posted on the bulletin board in the plant as well as in our office at the main warehouse.

I am also including a copy of this program for your files.

- #2. The recommendation of the purchase of a C-Kit for tank car leaks is being included in my request of needs for expenditures for 1977.

- #3. "Caution - Asbestos" signs have been posted at all locations where asbestos is stored.

I would like to remind you at this time that the only way we handle asbestos in the Tampa Branch is palletized shrink-wrapped. It goes out of the warehouse by the pallet. No broken shrink-wrapped pallets are on hand.

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- #8. The dangling light fixture on the warehouse dock was taken down 4/7/76.
- #9. Compressed gas tanks for the fork lift were secured by building a rack made of welded metal. Completed 3/6/76.
- #11. Completed 4/9/76.
- #12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, and 22:
All completed and handled 3/29/76 - the same day they were brought to our attention.
- #13. Safety Shower at HFF Tank - relocated 3/13/76.
- #18. Complete new driveway. Approximately 37 cubic yards, 3,000 lbs. stress concrete. Completed 4/30/76.
- #21. Completed 4/1/76.
- #23. Completed 4/5/76.

In reviewing this letter to this point, I noticed I failed to record #7. Records of Safety Committee Meetings are being kept on file.
