5 they teach you?

6 A General mechanics. Everything a general
7 mechanic would do -- engine, transmission, brakes.

8 Q And after you took that course, did you then
9 obtain a job in your field?

10 A Yes. I went to Aberdeen Proving Ground in
11 the automotive test and research division.

12 Q And what did you do there?

13 A General mechanic.

14 Q Approximately what year was that?

15 A That was 1941, '42.

16 Q And how long did you work at Aberdeen?

17 A It was about two years. Then I was drafted
18 into the Army.

19 Q Now, when you were at Aberdeen, did you do
20 any brake work?

21 A Yes.
