MEMORANDUM of telephone conversation today with:

Mr. Woodard - Johns-Manville, New York

Asbestos material coming on a case from Waukegan, Illinois, for our review and interpretation.

Man employed presumably in asbestos for 35 years.

Case examined by Dr. Irons, Chicago, some time ago. Made a diagnosis of Tuberculosis.

Patient died December 23, 1947. Autopsied at Hibbing, Minnesota. Diagnosis: ASBESTOSIS.

Industry now confronted with medicolegal proceedings.
