Dear [REDACTED],

Please allow me to contact you on behalf of Daikin regarding an exemption request for the REACH restriction proposal on C9-C14 PFAS which is currently being drafted by the European Commission.

Daikin owns the company Heroflon in Italy for the production of PTFE micropowder in Europe. The production of PTFE micropowder, requires a production step where electromagnetic irradiation is needed to 'break' PTFE into micropowder. During that production process C9-C14 substances are generated which are above the concentration limit that is indicated the restriction proposal.

For that reason Daikin would need to request a 5 year exemption with concentration limit of 1000 ppb for the sum of C9-C14 PFAS.

Please find attached the presentation which explains further the production process and the exemption request.
