You will remember that several sample bags of Spraydon A were made at South Plainfield some time ago. These samples were made in an effort to determine the cause of dust when applying this product. Due to the seriousness of the problem and after discussions with Carl Setterberg, the plant decided to go ahead with a job sheet proposal which would change the method of mixing the ingredients. In the meantime, we had hoped that the test results of these various samples would confirm the need for the equipment changes.

The plant has now submitted this job sheet and we should have some indication from spray on Research that this is the proper action to take. We note that you have been following up on Mr. Kempthorne for the results of this test, but apparently we have not heard from him.

The job sheet will be held until we hear from Mr. Kempthorne.
