Our meeting will be held in **Room 3144**.

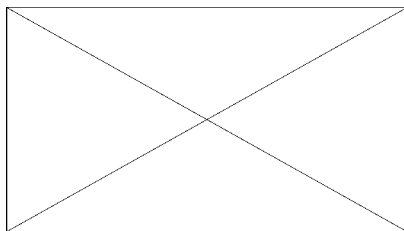

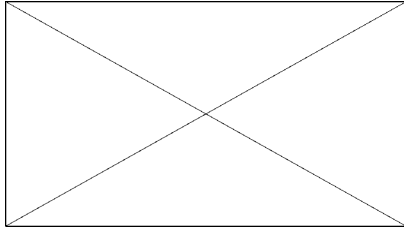

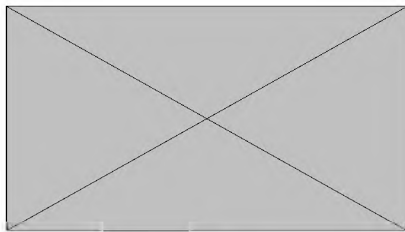
