In cases such as this, it is important that a diagnosis is established indicating the patient does have asbestosis. Further it is important to determine when Mr. Hanberg worked for Owens-Corning Fiberglass Corporation since it takes many years for clinical signs and symptoms of asbestosis to arise. Most importantly, it should be determined that he did indeed have asbestos exposure while in our employment.

It would seem reasonable that if his employment with us was of short duration and fairly recent, that our liability at best would be very small.
