Dear Mr. Regan:

The Department has reviewed reports submitted under Condition #8 of Operating Permit #A057-80795. We have reason to believe that State and Federal regulations were violated by emissions of vinyl chloride into the atmosphere. The State of Florida under Florida Administrative Code Rule 17-2.670 directly adopts Section 40 Part 61 of the Code of Federal Regulations in regulating the Emission of Hazardous Air Pollutants including vinyl chloride. The following violations were noted:
