

INTERROGATORY NO. 22: Please state the scientific or medical periodicals to which the Defendant, its medical department or industrial hygiene division subscribed during the period from 1930 to present specifying the date such subscriptions were begun.

ANSWER: Defendant objects to this Interrogatory as overbroad and burdensome. Defendant did subscribe to the Journal of Occupational Medicine since approximately 1941.
