DR. JAMES WEBSTER

Transcript, July 13, 1987:

"Q. And Dr. Dost, he testified that now with respect to porphyria and the causes of it, you mentioned chemicals such as hexachlorophene, and he said not hexachlorophene. We know (p. 115) that TCDD will cause porphyria. Hexachlorobenzene will cause porphyria. Dr. Dost in '85 didn't have the advantage, as you did, of reading the article by Jones and Chelsky published in the Archives of Environmental Health, did he, sir?

"A. No, he did not." (p. 116)

DR. FRANK DOST

Transcript, November 13, 1985:

"Q. And what about the Diamond Alkali incident?

"A. It has been established -- there is a paper in press in the Archives of Environmental Health which has established that there was also extensive hexachlorobenzene exposure in that situation as well.

"MR. CARR: Could you cite the article for us, Doctor, and when it was published?

"A. The senior author is Jones and the second author is Chelcus. I am not certain, I am sorry to say, but it is in press. It hasn't been printed yet. It is in press. It has been reviewed and it is in press in the Archives of Environmental Health." (p. 107)
