The items noted during the Safety & Housekeeping inspection of the Udex on May 15 have been corrected or Work Orders submitted to have them corrected.

Mr. Darby stated that the platform at 002 Compressor at Reformer #3 was not in the proper place for use to bar over the machine. Mr. Prescott said he would take action to have it put in the proper location.

Mr. Blackburn asked if any action was being taken to install air lines to the LPG Storage Tank area. Mr. Drick will take this up with Mr. Roy.

Mr. Blackburn asked if any action had been taken on obtaining cotton coveralls for employees. Mr. Stewart reported that the subject had been discussed at the May Management, Mr. Johnston will talk to management on this.

Mr. Darby asked if the insulation on FE 1A & B in the FCC would be replaced. Mr. Prescott answered that it would be replaced with a new removable insulation.

Mr. Darby showed a gland gasket he found in the Warehouse to Mr. Stewart that was marked "Asbestos"; he was told we would no longer use asbestos in the plant. Mr. Stewart took the gasket and said he would see that non-asbestos gaskets would be used.

Mr. Blackburn asked Mr. Stewart if the Electricians had the proper license to drive the winch truck. Mr. Stewart said no special license was required to drive the vehicle.

Mr. Rogers asked Mr. Stewart why truck 981 that was flooded recently at #1 Trap was allowed to be driven when the seats had been soaked with hydrocarbons; the people have plastic and burlap bags on the seats and still are getting their clothing damp. Mr. Stewart said new seats are on order. In the meantime he would look into the matter.
