My dear Kehoe:

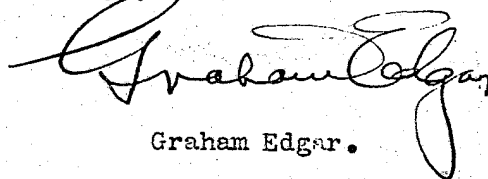
