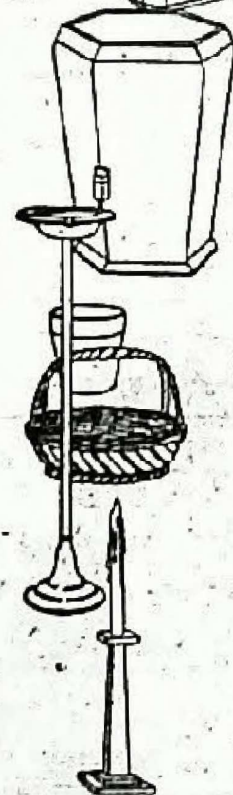


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more than 16 in 1913 to 28 in 1921, whereas Great Britain's share dropped from 16 to 12 per cent and Germany's declined from 9 to 4 per cent.

In China, according to Mr. Klein's data, the American gain was even more impressive during the same period, rising from 4 to 14 per cent, while England's share fell from 14 to 11 per cent and Germany's from 5 to 3 per cent. Even in India, a supposedly impregnable stronghold of British trade, though still dominated by her merchants, the American gain on the increase was about 2.1 per cent.
