



Mechanical Pollution Prevention[®] Asbestos

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Store and Dispose of Used Parts Safely

Used parts with the possibility of asbestos contamination and asbestos dust must be carefully disposed of according to federal, state and local regulations for asbestos materials.



keep in mind

Place asbestos, asbestos HEPA vacuum filters or HEPA collection bags directly into a 6 milliliter (heavy) plastic bag and then double tie the bag. Place it directly into a 55-gallon drum or similar leak-proof, air-tight container designated for asbestos waste according to OSHA regulations and mark it as follows:

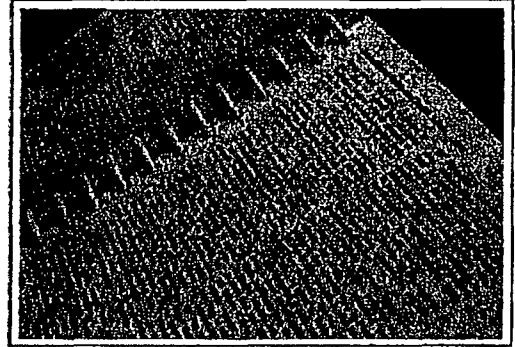
CAUTION

Keep the drum for asbestos waste locked between filter or collection bag changes. Transport and disposal of asbestos waste should be done only by individuals familiar with procedures for handling asbestos waste in accordance with EPA's asbestos disposal guidance. OSHA asbestos waste disposal regulations are covered under 29 CFR 1910.1001 (j)(2).
