Dear Mr. Yates:

This will acknowledge the receipt of the report which was sent out under date of June 24th and which came to my attention on my return from the weekend a day or two ago.

In going over this report, it seems to us that Part I is satisfactory. Exhibit A is apparently O.K. as is apparently Part II. We feel that it might be wise in Part III on page 16 to eliminate the reference to Appendix B, and Mr. Larson and I both feel that Appendix II could be left out without detriment to the case. As the Government is probably not interested in this detail. By leaving out Appendix B we think that possibly further conference at Washington might be eliminated although of course this is not certain.

Three different methods described might raise the question as to which is the most efficient, and why the three parties do not agree on a uniform method. There seems to be no reason for discussing the method of the mix. The results are apparently satisfactory, and these are what count. It is well to call attention to the fact that further work is being done and that this further work may modify the methods of mixing, blending and sampling.

The report seems to be carefully prepared and I should regard it as in general highly satisfactory.
