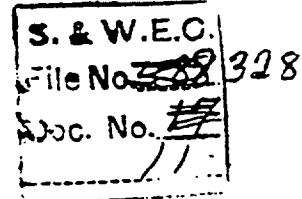

Under date of May 31, 1946, we authorized Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation to prepare preliminary plans and a cost estimate for drumming facilities at Baton Rouge. This work was undertaken under Part I of our Term Contract with Stone & Webster. This study was assigned J.O. 7810 by Stone & Webster and is now complete.

We are today authorizing Stone & Webster to proceed with the design and construction of the drumming facilities for Baton Rouge. Under our Term Contract, Stone & Webster is authorized to invoice us under Part I at their regular expert or per diem rate, except in such cases where the project is subsequently authorized under Part II of our Term Contract, in which case the charge is to be adjusted to 2/3 their regular expert or per diem rate.

Since the work completed under J.O. 7810 is being authorized by us under Part II of the Term Contract, the invoice covering same should be at 2/3 of Stone & Webster's regular expert or per diem rate. An invoice in accordance therewith will be acceptable. The invoice should show on its face that the charge is adjusted to 2/3 their regular expert or per diem rate by virtue of subsequent authorization under Part II of our Term Contract.
